Daily Reading

Share a story with your child every day – repetition is really useful!

Writing Task

Write a postcard to me, Mrs. Carr, to introduce yourself, tell me about you, your favourite foods, places to visit, activities and about your friends and family.

Numeracy Focus – fractions

Fold pieces of paper into halves and quarters. Share marbles, toys or treats into groups of equal amounts. Roll playdough sausages, can you share them fairly onto 4 plates? Serve pieces of food equally at meal times. Cut pieces of bread into squares. Cut a pizza into 6 / 8 pieces, how many pieces do we get each? Fold laundry into half, quarters – can we make it smaller?

Topic: Toys

What is your favourite toy? Can you draw a picture of it and label it? How does it work? Can it move? Why is it your favourite toy? Where did you get it? How much was it? Where was it made? What material is it made from? Does anyone else in your house have a favourite toy?

Ongoing ideas to support your Year 1 child:

Bedtime story

Write a sentence about the highlight of your day.

Helping – setting the table, preparing meals, tidying bedrooms!

Reading signs, numbers in the world around you.

Carry on focusing on learning to read, write and spell your high frequency words.

In the car, look at number plates. Can we read whole numbers?
