Numeracy Focus – number

Make 2 sets of number cards from 0 to 10. Choose pairs – can you add them. Can you find 2 numbers that add up to 20? Arrange numbers to 20 in order, if one digit is removed can you identify the missing number? Write numbers to 20 and beyond if you can. Give children a set of objects – how many more do you need to make 20?

Topic: Toys

Can you write a list of your favourite toys? Design a toy shop – using a piece of A4 paper, draw around 2D shapes in order to fill the page will blank shapes. Draw pictures of a toy inside each shape in order to create your own toy shop. Can you come up with an exciting name and logo for your shop?
