Here are some of the details for Laa Columb Beg, which is taking place at school on Friday 25th June.

Order of events.

8.45 am – children arrive at school for registration.

9.00 am - fancy dress competition in hall.

12.00 – lunch – eat outside if fine.

1.10 pm register children and gather together in KS1 playground for procession.

1.30 pm - Opening ceremony.

2.00 pm - Manx dancing.

2.10 pm - Choir singing.

2.15 pm - Break - Children to get changed for sports. Time to view children's work, face painting, scavenger hunt, flag treasure hunt and raffle. Tea/coffee/juice/ice cream/cake and hot dogs available.

3.00 pm - Bell rings and all school children meet their teachers on the field for fun sports.

4.00 pm - Laa Columb beg closes.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will not be allowed to walk around the fair without an adult. They will go into their classroom after the opening and may be picked up from there. Any children who do not have adults with them will be looked after by staff members and they will be given a chance to spend their money on cakes/hot dogs etc.

If you are unable to attend and your child needs to go home on the bus, please inform the secretary by email before the day, so that we can arrange for staff members to ensure they leave the sports and get onto the bus.
