Sports Events

We have been notified of a few cases around school. Please take time to check your child's hair regularly. Parents report that using conditioner and products such as a nitty gritty comb (other similar products are available) help greatly and reduce the amount of chemical treatments when dealing with an infestation.

Car Park

Please take care when using the school car park as there have been a few minor scrapes in recent weeks. The staff car park should not be used for drop off and pick up as this can create a potential danger for children especially in the morning when children are walking into school via the back gate. Children can travel between their home and school, if you consider them able to travel independently, for 40p per journey with a pre-paid Go School smart travel card. Those travelling to school without a card pay the half the standard fare to their destination. Please inform your child of their after school collection or bus plans before they come to school.
