

Uniform

Please make sure that your child's name is written clearly on the label or that a name label is attached to each item of clothing - including coats and PE kit. KS2 children should also have their name on swimming kit.

If you have items of pre-loved uniform, please make sure that the correct name is visible so that it is not returned to the previous owner.

Children must wear black shoes **NOT** trainers for school. Some older pupils like to bring trainers to wear at break times for playing football outside and they can change into these at playtimes - but trainers are only for outside wear at school.

PE Kits

Please can you ensure that your child has a PE kit in school every week. Children need shorts and a t-shirt. Correct footwear is pumps not trainers for indoor PE lessons but children should bring trainers for lessons and clubs outside.

Children with long hair must have it tied back for PE sessions and children with pierced ears must take out their earrings or have them covered with micro-pore tape.

Swimming / PE / Games

Children in Years 3, 4 5, and 6 will all have weekly swimming sessions at the Southern Swimming Pool on a **Thursday** morning. (Starting 14th September)

Please ensure that children have their kit each Thursday and if there is any reason why your child cannot swim, the class teacher must be informed by letter. Children who are not able to swim for a medical reason will still travel to the pool with their class. Please note that baggy shorts and two-piece swimsuits are not allowed for lessons and that any children who have long hair must wear a swimming cap.

Music Lessons

Children in Years 5 and 6 who have lessons with the peripatetic music staff should bring their instruments on the same days as last year. Lessons will start again in the week beginning 11th September. Ms Hope's before school strings group will not restart on the 14th September but her violin lessons will be on that afternoon.

School Buses

Children are able to take the No.64 Ronague / Colby bus which goes around the Ronague and Colby Glen Rds to the Methodist Chapel in Colby. This bus now leaves a little later on the new timetables.

The children using the No.1/11 bus to Onchan will now leave first as the timetable change means that this bus leaves at just after 3.30pm.

Go Cards can be used on the buses and are cheaper than the half fare price.

Please also note that although teachers kindly take turns in carrying out a 'bus duty' this is not part of their Ts and Cs of employment and any issues regarding the buses should be directed to Bus Vannin. The school does not hold any information about who is travelling on the buses each day.

End of the day

All the children who are not on the bus will leave from the car park end of the hall. Please can I ask that parents don't congregate around the main school entrance and path as we need clear access for the children going home by bus. Care should also be taken when using the car park as at this time it is particularly busy.

Parents Meetings

This year staff will offer one slot during the school day where parents can come to meet the new teacher. Meetings should be booked through the Arbor Parent Portal which will be open for bookings at **1.30pm on Monday 25th September.**

Southern Food Bank

Thanks to everyone who supported the Food Bank last term. Collections will now resume and items can be placed in the container by the front entrance.
