Walk the children to school where possible

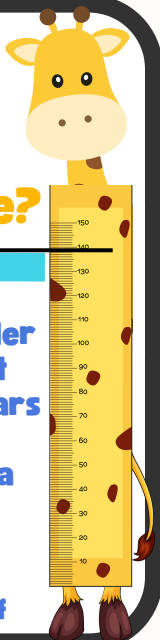
Car Seats
