

# **Headteacher Update**

Welcome to October, the month we celebrate Harvest and thank our farmers for their hard work and dedication, take time to remember Trafalgar, and enjoy the festivities of Hop tu Naa. Please pay close attention to the dates shared and keep an eye on Dojo for updates. We are also hosting our first 'Stay and Learn' event for parents this half term - an opportunity to observe and join in with classroom learning (2025 style!) and to share the children's progress so far this school year. Please enter via the main school entrance and make your way to your child's classroom from 1:30pm on Tuesday 14th October. Finally, a gentle reminder not to park in the staff car park during drop-off and pick-up times. We appreciate that parking can be challenging, but safety remains our top priority on the school site.

## **END OF DAY COLLECTION NEW ARRANGEMENTS FROM MONDAY**

Currently, all children exit through the hall entrance at the end of the day. This can cause congestion and make it harder for parents and children to find each other safely.

To help make collection smoother and safer, we will be using additional exits from Monday onwards:

- Reception (YR) and Year 1 (Y1) will leave via the entrance by the Y1 classroom at the far end of the school.
- Year 2 (Y2) will leave via the main entrance.
- Years 3-6 will continue to leave through the main hall entrance.

We hope this change will make the end of the day calmer, safer, and more efficient for everyone. Thank you for your cooperation and continued support as we trial this new arrangement.
